

# 90/90 Attendance Performance (As of 9/15/2023)

The attendance rate for August is comparable to last year, even though this August represents ~15 additional students. The 90/90 attendance rates are better than the end of SY22-23; however, approximately 20% of students (K-6) are not reaching the 90% attendance goal. The majority of those students are in the 'Less than 85%' band. The student support team is reviewing the data to understand the barriers to attendance and to work with families who currently have low attendance.

## Updates from our student support team

- Big Smiles is continuing to partner with AFIA to provide dental services to our students. Our first day for this year was September 11th and 15 students were provided with dental services on the first day.
- We have held two mobile food pantries thanks to our partners at Harvesters and School Smart KC. In August, 47 families participated. In September, 37 families participated.
- We are continuing our partnership with Swope Behavioral Health Services.
  This school year, we have already referred eight additional students for services.
