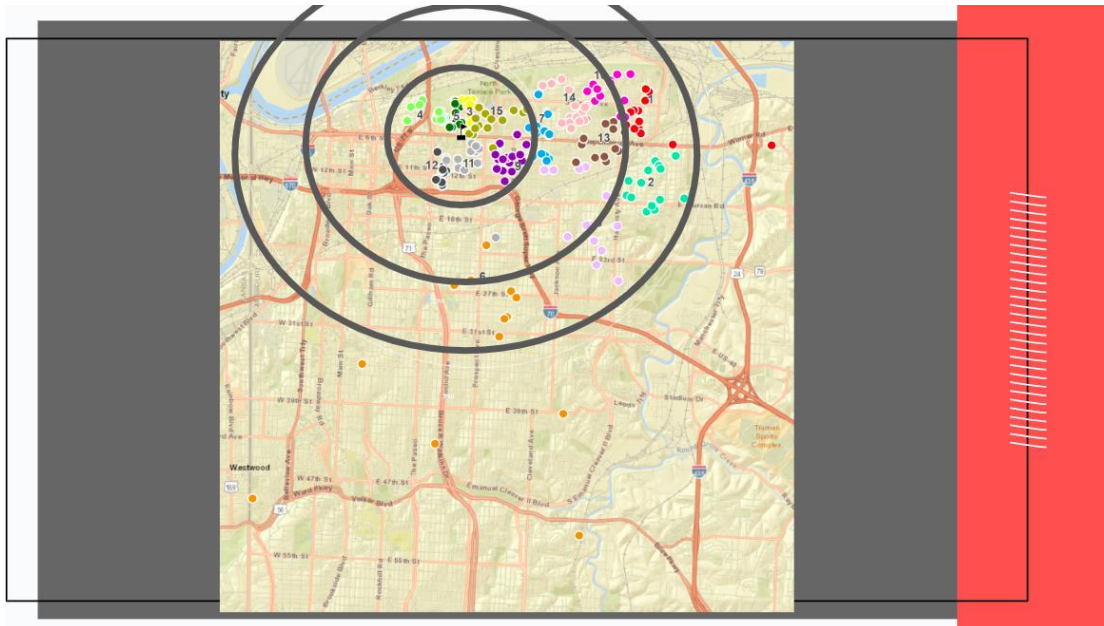
## Back to School Night

## Home Visits

SVN had 15 teams visit 14-16 homes the week before school. Our team conducted a total of 218 home visits.

## Instructional Time

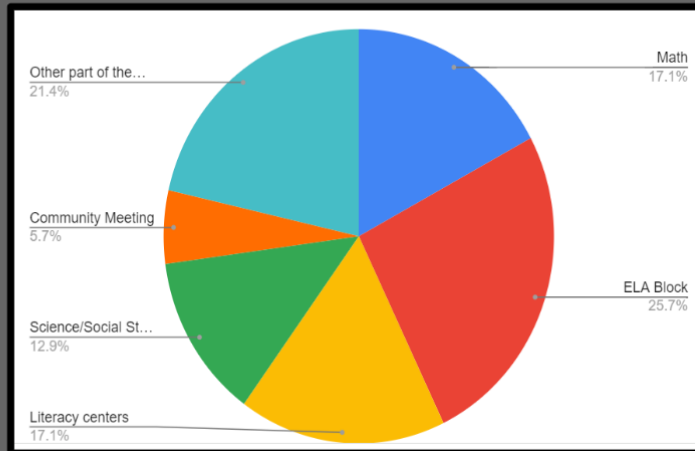
Time on task is important in order for our students to continue to make progress. We want our staff to be mindful of maximizing instructional time with students.

### How much Instructional time do we have in K-4?

#### Recommended Timeframe

Community Meeting: 20 minutes  
Math: 60 - 90 minutes  
ELA Block - 90 minutes  
Literacy centers: 60 minutes  
Science/Social Studies (A/B): 45 minutes  
**Total: 275 out of 350**  
*Time for Restroom Breaks, and Etc.  
(75+ minutes depending on math block)*

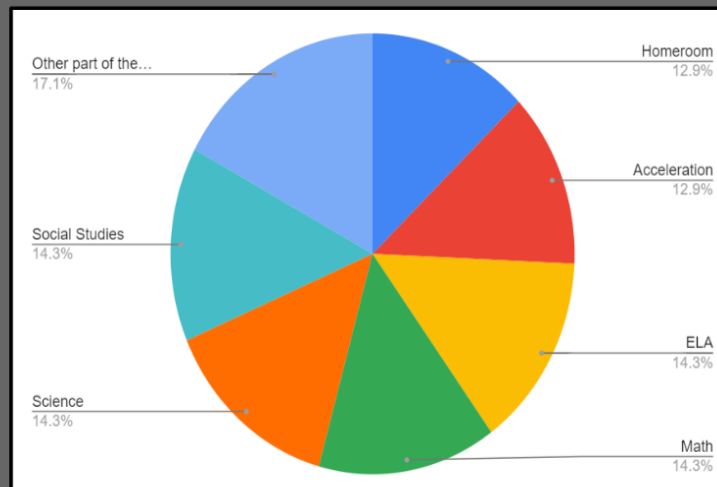
78.6% of the schedule is instructional time



### How much Instructional time do we have in 5th-8th?

#### Recommended Timeframe

Homeroom: 45 minutes (on average)  
Acceleration: 45 minutes (on average)  
ELA: 50 minutes  
Math: 50 minutes  
Science: 50 minutes  
Social Studies: 50 minutes  
**Total: Cores: 200 minutes/ 290 including Homeroom and Acceleration out of 350 minutes**  
82.85% of the schedule is instructional time available.

# KEEPING SVN SAFE

The safety of our students and staff is our top priority. Below are security measures in place at SVN, as well as steps staff members can personally take to increase safety and security around the campus. Communication and collaboration are key to our safety.



## Locked Doors

Exterior doors are locked at all times. Classroom doors all lock.



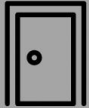
## Visitor Management

All visitors check in through a buzz-in intercom system prior to entry.



## Intruder Resistant Film

Main office windows have an intruder resistant film, allowing staff to see out but visitors to not see in.



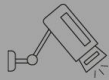
## Double Door Vestibule

## Safety Drills

All students and staff participate in Tornado, Fire, Earthquake, and Intruder drills throughout the year



## Security Cameras

50+ cameras are strategically placed around the interior and exterior of the building



## Security Officers

SVN partners with Titan Security for on-call security support

## What can I do to keep myself and students safe?

- Stay alert - keep your eyes up and open.
- Do not prop doors open. Always check to ensure doors are securely latched.
- Greet every visitor and check for a visitor badge. If no badge is visible, escort the visitor to the main office.
- Actively supervise students by scanning the area and strategically placing yourself in a way that you can supervise all students.
- If something seems odd, report it to administration immediately.



## Staff Updates

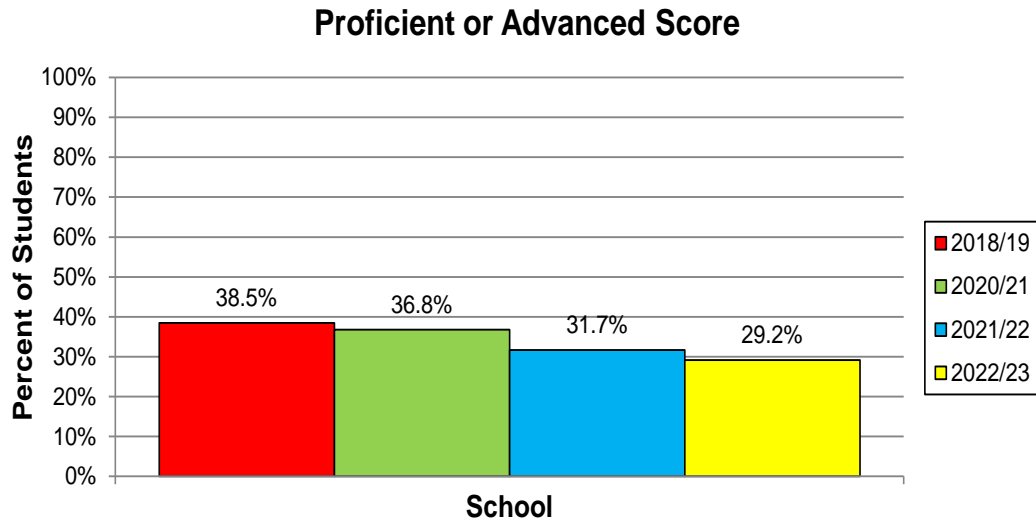

- Substitute/SVN Grow Your Own moved to 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Social Studies

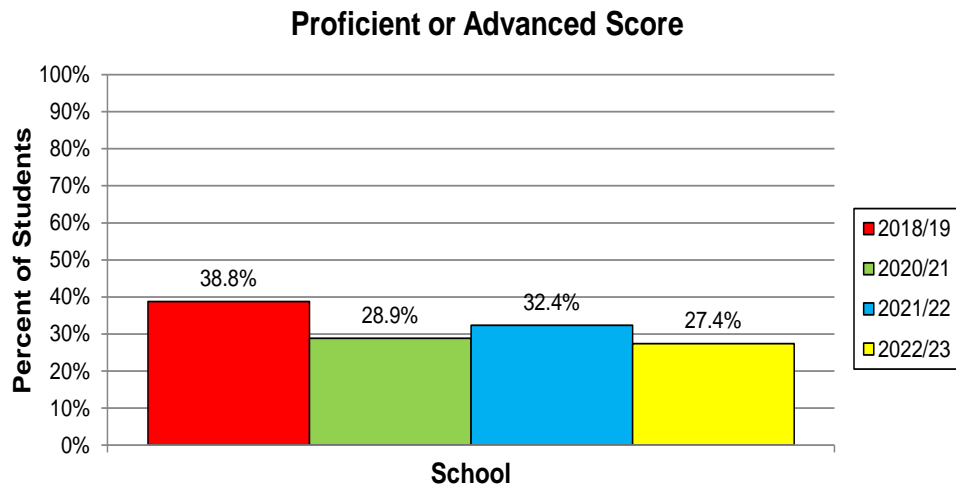
## Missouri Assessment Program (MAP)
