<u>Finance Report</u>

Month Ending August 31st, 2024 Summary Financials:

Bryan reviewed the Financials through August using the Finance Executive Summary. Revenue exceeded expenses for the moth by \$21,360. Revenue is within \$313 of budgeted amount and exceeds expenditures by \$106,515. Expenses are below budgeted amount to date, primarily because transportation and some smaller contracts have not yet been billed and paid. Assets as of August 31st, 2024 are \$3,287,454.

Action Item 3. Motion to Approve the August, 2024 Financial Report: Dr. Tom Stephens

<u>Academic Report</u> Vincent Wright

Improvement Plan Update: Mr. Wright update the full board on the Academic improvement focus area and progress to date. Instructional leaders scored teachers on the Focused Instruction Rubric, conducted additional feedback and training based on the results and then observed and scored again. 8 of 11 teachers scored proficient (3 or above), with 3 making progress but not there yet.

Special Education Update: Ms. Lorie Friend of Exceptional Support Group briefed the board on the results of the 23-24 DESE program review. The school is required to address one area of non-compliance related to an individual students IEP. Ms. Friend also covered the 2024-25 school year caseload. There are currently 30 students receiving special education services, 13 of them in grades 7 and 8. 13 students have diagnosed learning disabilities and 9 receive services for other

health impairment. There are 11 students receiving Speech Therapy and 6 receiving Occupational Therapy.

Executive Director Report Information Items:

Kevin Foster

- 1. **Enrollment and Attendance Update:** As of September 21st, there are 182 students enrolled, 10 in Pre-K and 172 in grades K-8. or the upcoming school year we have reenrolled 84.7% of the targeted amount for students. We are still accepting applications and will discuss enrollment numbers at the board off-site. Average Daily attendance is 163 students (92.87%). To date 5 students have transferred out, 2 to KCPS and 3 to charters.
- **2. Staffing Update:** There have been 2 changes to staffing identified in the staffing update. There is a new 7-8 grade science teacher and a new 7-8 grade ELA teacher.
- 3. **Charter Renewal Planning:** Kevin Foster updated the board on meetings with Commission staff and the status of the application narrative. The board reviewed the renewal timeline and discussed upcoming events. MAP data is expected to be released and public by November 12th. The Commission public hearing is tentatively scheduled December 3rd to support a commission vote on December 16th. The Commission has also added another site visit to the agenda, scheduled for November 12th and 13th.






ELA Trends







Math Trends








Achievement Levels- Map and Evaluate

Analysis

- Consistent with iReady results, the October Evaluate data indicates that the 24-25 MAP testing cohort starts at about the same place as 2025. 4th and 8th grade will require additional support for students below basic.
- While iReady results were comparative to 23-24 in math, October Evaluate scores outpace 23-24. This progress is most evident in Grades 7 and 8.
 Additional support is being provided to grades 5 and 6. Potentially, we could make another significant improvement in Math status.
- Leaders, teachers, support staff and facilitators did detailed analysis of results in October. Evidence of progress should be apparent in December.
