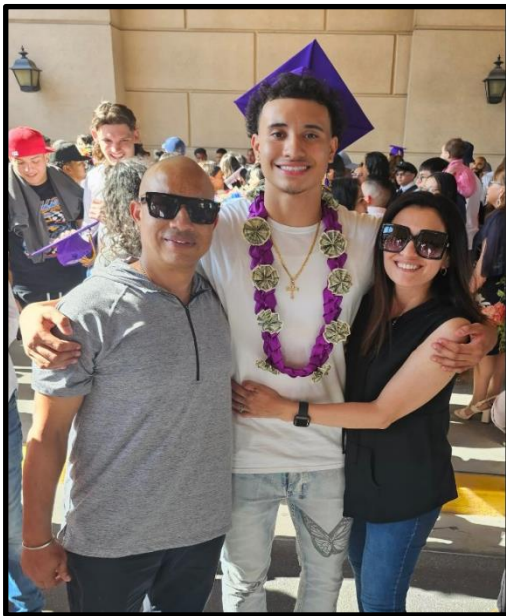

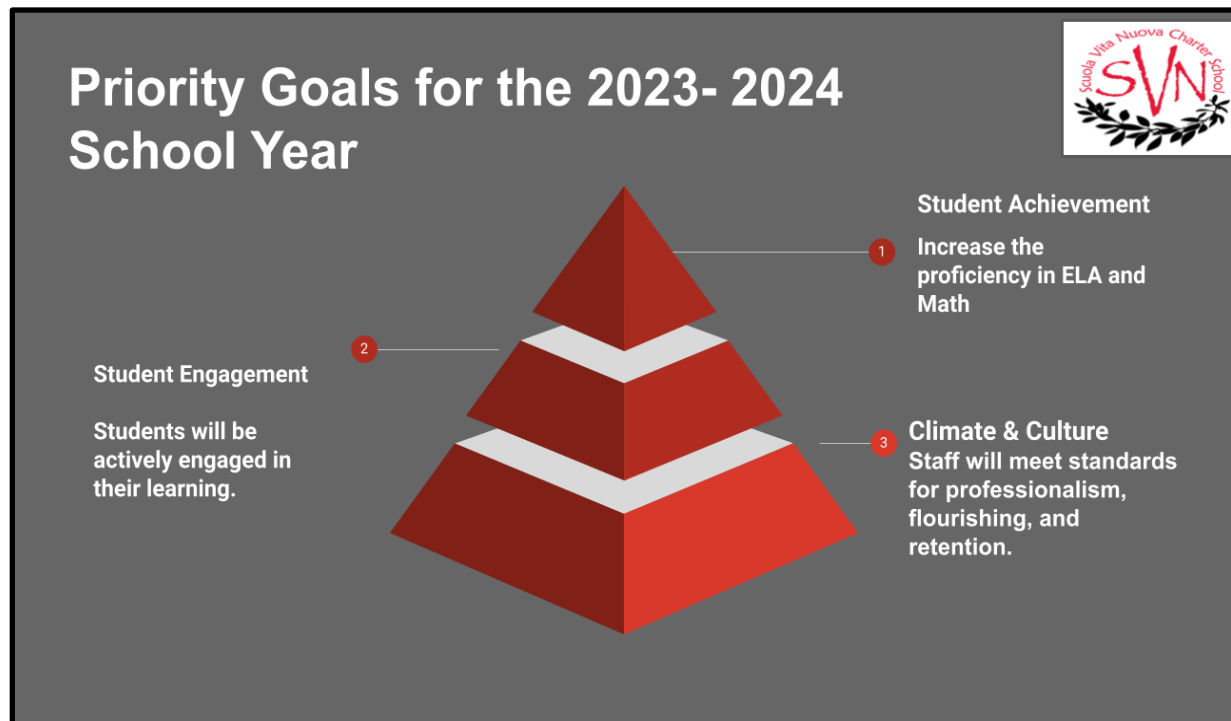

In addition to these new positions, several more were filled internally due to the lack of applicants and qualified candidates. We had to move a staff member to the second grade teacher position and another to the 5th/6th math teacher position. Mrs. Goodman will provide more specifics in her report to the board.

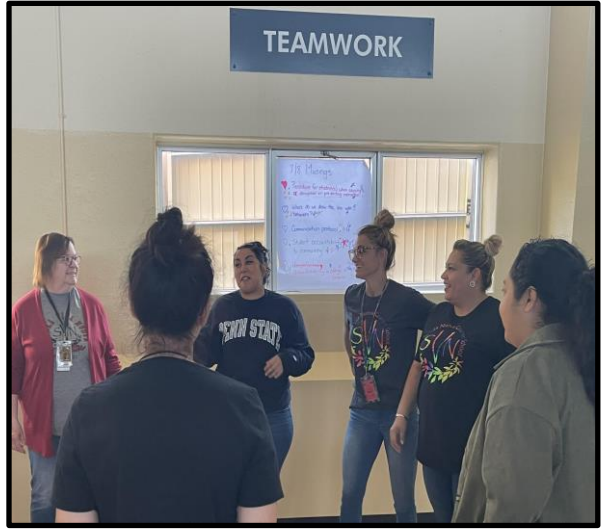

Target Outcomes of this work are as follows:

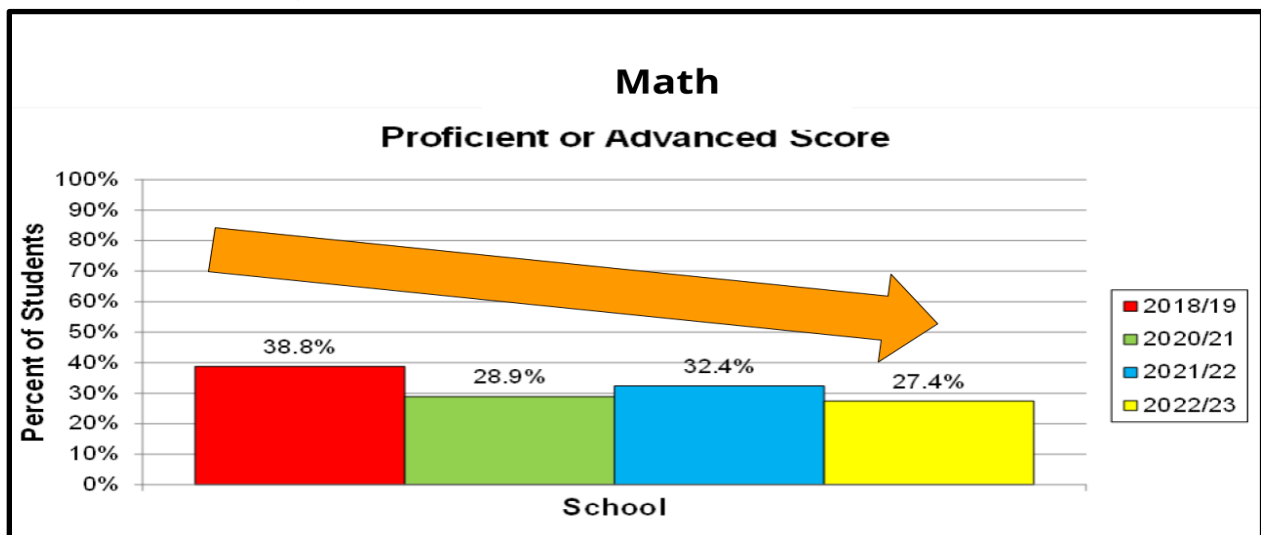
- Teacher and staff levels of flourishing will increase.
- Teacher burnout levels will decrease, as measured by the Harvard Human Flourishing Scale, Work and Teacher Flourishing Scale, and Teacher Burnout Scale.
- SVN will continue to see high levels of teacher retention.





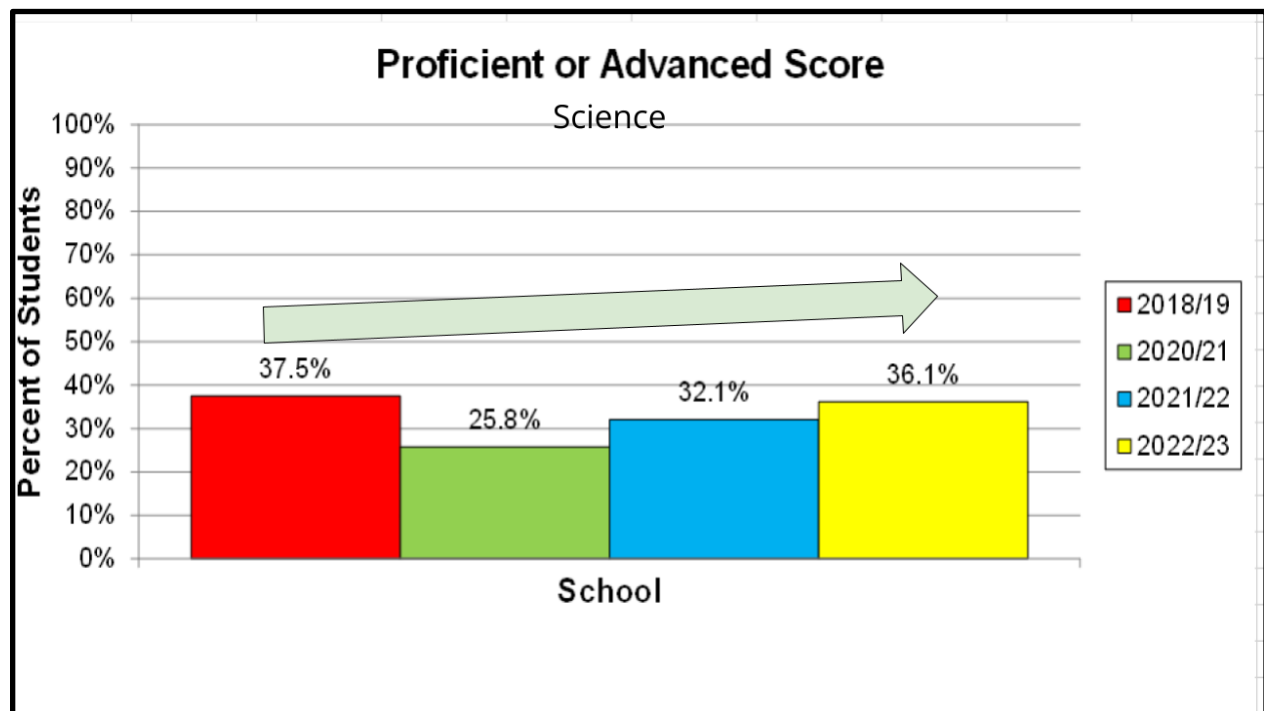
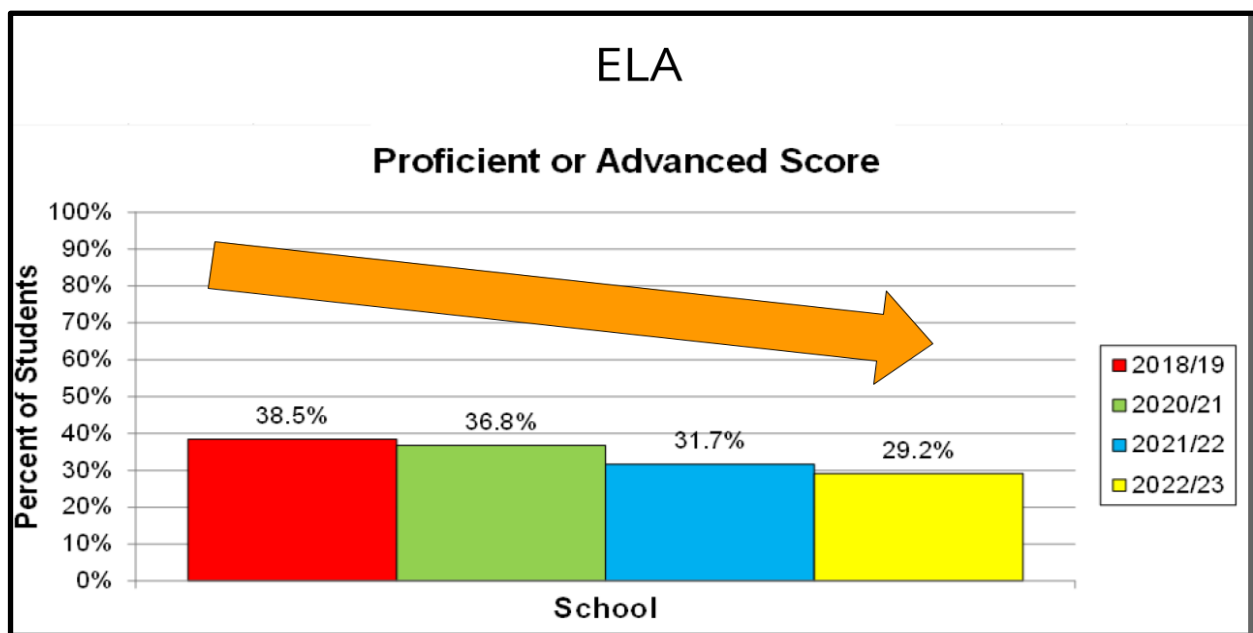
MAP Data: Preliminary State Assessment Results

Our 2023 State Assessment results show a drop in both ELA and Math assessments. However, our science scores increased from the 2022 State Assessment. State results are currently embargoed until finalized data are released from DESE.



Even though state assessments only tell part of the story of our students' development, growth, and needs, it is an important part that our teachers and staff must pay attention to, so students reach their full academic potential.

Staff will continually evaluate state assessment results to identify trends and individual student learning needs. This will help us improve teaching and learning across our school and meet student achievement goals. We will monitor students' progress and learning towards the grade level Missouri Learning Standards by providing personalized interventions and acceleration in real time. Thus, increasing proficiency, but also reducing the number of students in Below Basic. These metrics will be tracked at each tested grade level as well as sub-groups of students in SPED and ELL.
