Finance Report

2022-23 Audit: Clark Hanner of Marr & Company reviewed the 2022-23 Audit with the full board, including the management letter. The audit has also been reviewed by the Executive Committee at the December meeting. There were no findings.

<u>Action Item 3. Motion to Accept the FY 22-23 Audit Report as prepared by Marr & Company :</u>
<u>Dr. Tom Stephens:</u> Motion to approve by: Beth Ruf and seconded by Dan Haley; the motion approved unanimously.

FY 2023-2024 Budget Modification: The board reviewed the Budget Modification as forwarded by the Finance Committee.

Action Item 4. Motion to Approve the FY 2023-2024 Budget Modification: Dr. Tom Stephens Motion to approve by: Kenda Caskey and seconded by Beth Ruf; the motion approved unanimously.

Month Ending December 31st, Financials: Mr. Dempsey reviewed the finances through December using the executive summary. The board reviewed current state of liquidity, revenues,

expenditures, expenses, and net income. Federal revenues are sitting at about 24% of budgeted amount because these funds are paid as reimbursables. Salaries and benefits are running 8% below budget due to not having a payroll in July for most of the staff. Legal fees are running ahead of the budgeted amount due to litigation regarding the State's appeal. Education technology is at 129% of budget, and supplies are heavier but should come into line with the expected projected budget. Next month's financials will reflect the changes approved in the budget modification.

Action Item 5. Motion to Approve the December, 2023 Financial Report: Motion to approve by: Kenda Caskey and seconded by Ashley Garrett; the motion approved unanimously.

ACADEMIC AND PROGRAMMING REPORT: The board was briefed on the "Academic Improvement Priority Plan, developed as facilitated by SchoolWorks utilizing the School Quality Review. The team highlighted areas of growth requiring sustainment in safe and supportive learning environment, procedures for identifying students needs, engaging families, and providing financial oversight by the board of directors. The areas highlighted for target growth were Focused Instruction and feedback. Instructional leaders developed a plan for rolling out improvement in these areas, conducting professional development, observation, feedback and coaching and assessment with the goals of 80% of staff scoring a 3 on the Schoolworks rubric by April.

Board Calendar: Our sponsor will be conducting a site visit, including a board interview in April. This motion changes the board meeting calendar in order to have a closed session to conduct the interview.

Charter Contract Modifications: The Board reviewed the status of their proposed contract changes. The Commission denied the request to change the status goal, but requested the Genesis board approve the growth goal change. The Commission's proposal to change the charter contract goals.

Action Item 7. Motion to Direct staff to reengage the Commission staff on the status goal as part of changing the growth goal language in the Charter Contract: Motion to approve by: Kenda Caskey and seconded by Ashley Garrett; the motion approved unanimously.

Intent to seek Renewal of Charter in 2025: The Board reviewed language developed and reviewed by staff and the Performance Committee notifying the Commission of the intent to pursue renewal of our charter.

Executive Director Report

Information Items:

1. Attendance and Enrollment Update: We are currently at 200 students enrolled and there is a waiting list of 154 students. The classes that are full are: 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 8th grades. The average daily attendance is 182. The total withdraw rate is 15, reasons are to transfer out of the district, expulsion, another charter, pending transfers and unknown.

2. **Staffing Update:** Kevin presented the staff update highlighting changes of the staff since the beginning of the school year. Ms. Ramsey is now the full-time 1st grade teacher. Mr. Pollock is now the middle school ELA teacher, and we are currently working on getting all of the paraprofessional staff substitute certified or para professional certified.

Liquidity

We have finally worked off the overpayment from the state. Our overall cash and investments is down from the start of the year despite running a slight surplus because of the investment we made in the playground.

Revenue

We have several areas revenue that are lagging behind expectations for this time of year.

Title Funds - This is behind due to timing (reimbursement model). We expect to receive all of our allocation this year.

Special Education - We typically have several students attending other schools on a contract basis because we are not equipped to meet their needs. Only two students fit that category this year. Both enrolled late. One has already left. Expenditures that we normally allocate to this program been really low. But we can allocate other expenditures to this particular grant and utilize all of these funds this year.

Local Govt Funding - This line is low because we are not receiving any funds from the mental health levy. We have been unable to hire all the counselors that are typically funded by this program. Thus, we have not been able to generate all the billable services necessary to utilize their funds. We are actually still trying to work off revenue received in prior years.

Foundations/Businesses - We have been receiving \$100,000 a year from the Health Forward Foundation. However, we missed the normal grant cycle last spring when we were uncertain as to wheter we would be open or not.

Expenses

Legal Services - Continue to spend about \$10,000 a month responding to the state's appeal.

The Commission is deeply grateful to the board, management, teachers, parents, students, and community at Genesis School, Inc. for all you do to serve the children of Kansas City.

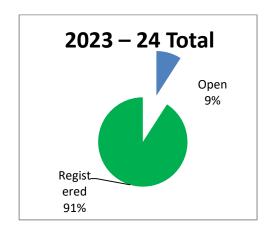
