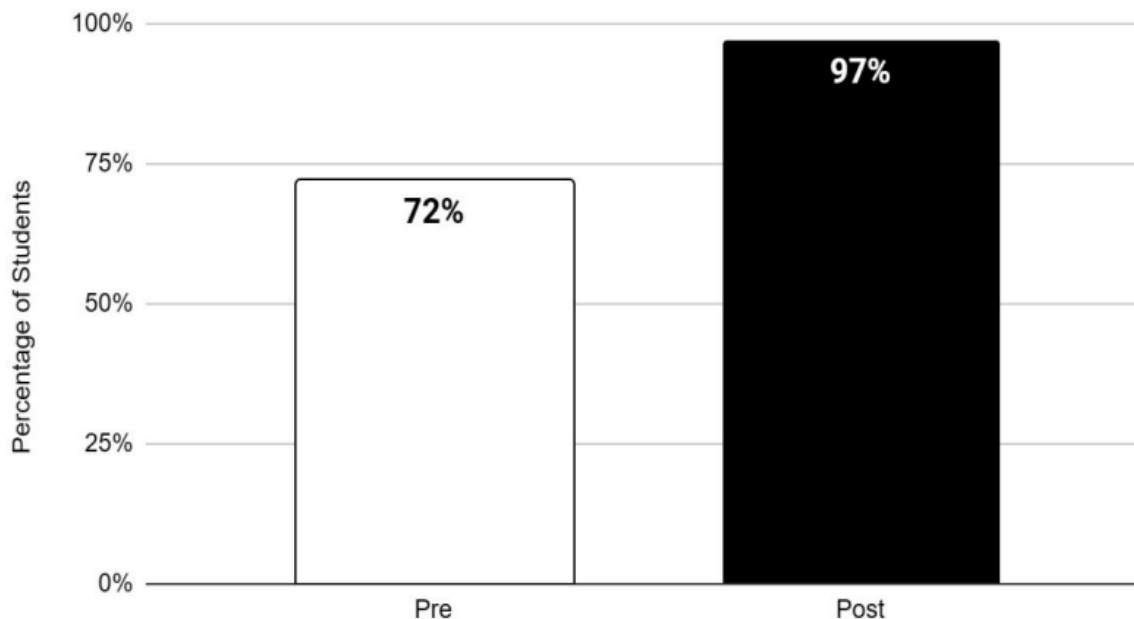

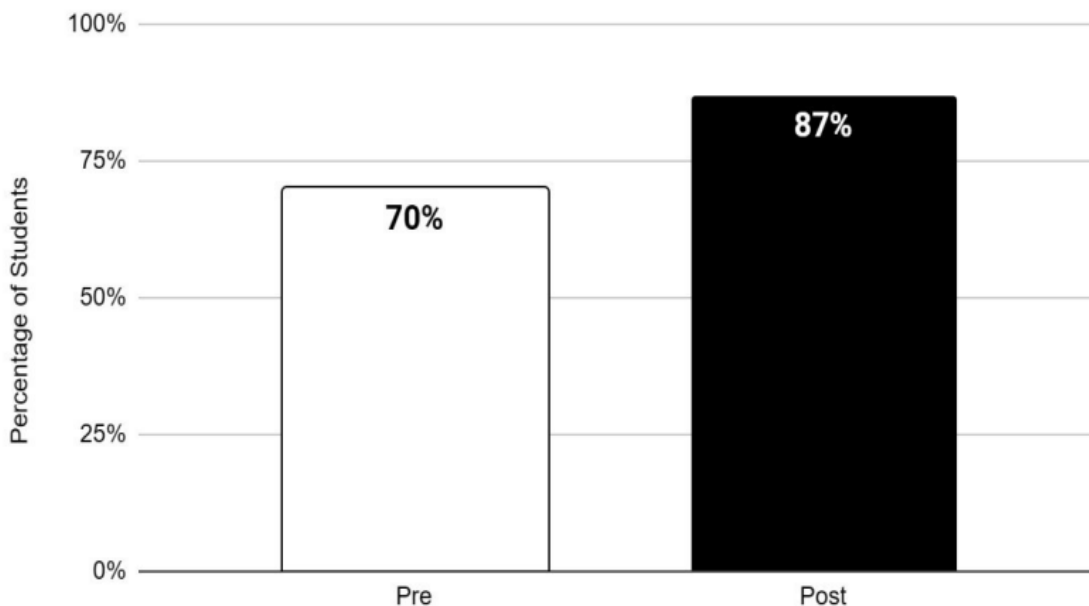

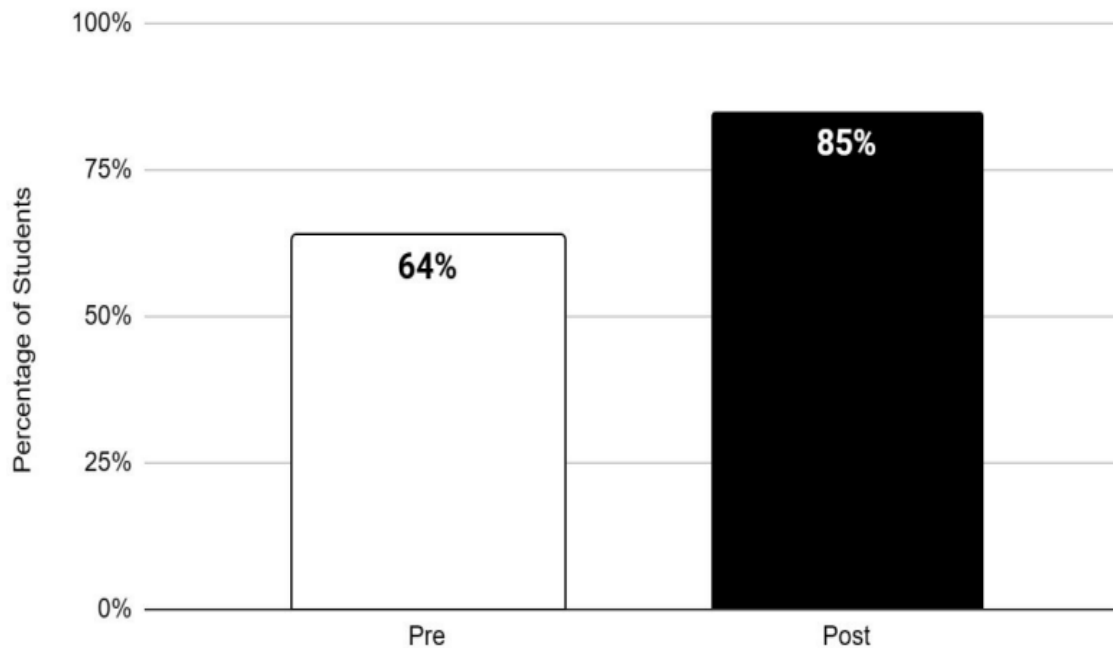

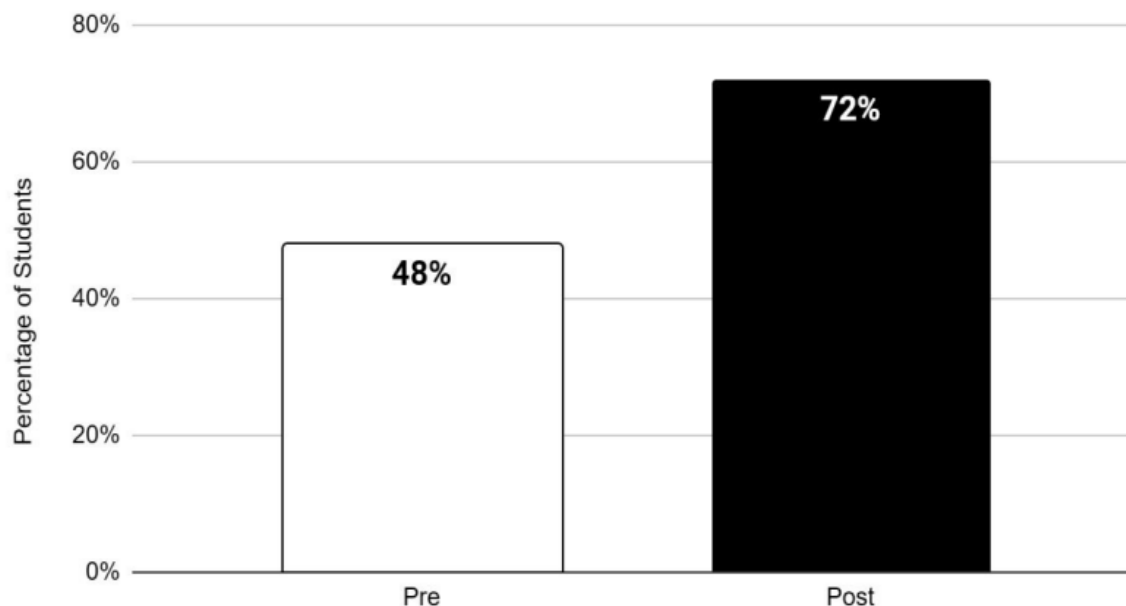

# Student Achievement

## Overall Findings & Summary

- SVN student made **remarkable** word-level gains, enabling them to accurately decode words.
- Most SVN students were working on Hoot's **Early Word Reading** units and are now ready for instruction and practice with **Complex Word Reading**.
- Future tutoring with the same students would likely focus on more complex phonics skills: silent letters, syllable types, etc., as well as moving into **Fluency practice**.

*"I can see a boost in several students' confidence. Kids that were quiet at first have developed a confident connection with their tutors."*

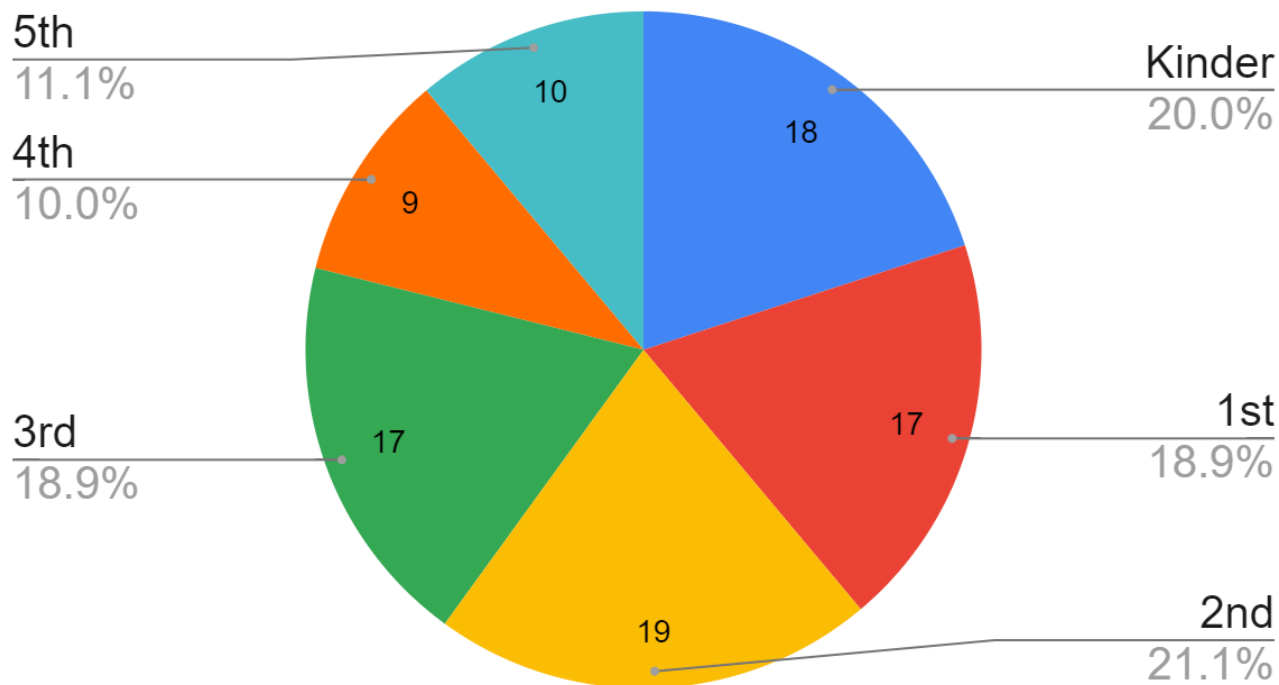
Average Independent Reading Gains = 1.23 years

## Recommendations and Next Steps:

- Continuing 25 min, 3x week, 10 week cycles
- Continue the ongoing participation of current students into enrollment to expand further in the area of Complex Phonic Skills
- Increase # of students participating in next enrollment (adding new students to expand impact)
- Estimated cost for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester = \$60,000- \$120,000

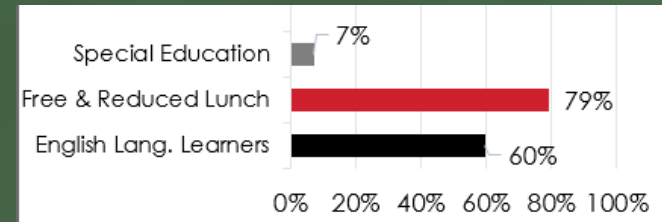

# School Calendar



The 2024-2025 school calendar proposed meets the DESE requirements. (see statue below) The school day will be 8:00 A.M. - 3:30 P.M. We will release every Wednesday at 2:00 P.M. This will allow time for professional development with staff.

Missouri statute directs that *each school board shall prepare annually a calendar for the school term* per Section 171.031.1, RSMo. The school term shall consist of one thousand forty-four hours of actual pupil attendance which shall be required with no minimum number of school days required, and "school day" shall mean any day in which, for any amount of time, pupils are under the guidance and direction of teachers in the teaching process. For kindergarten and prekindergarten grade levels the board shall provide a minimum of five hundred twenty-two hours of actual pupil attendance in a term with no minimum number of school days.
