



MAP Test Update

Scuola Vita Nuova Charter School

Lead to Read KC has partnered with Hoot Reading to improve literacy skills and attitudes towards reading for children at Scuola Vita Nuova Charter School. Together, we helped students access evidence-based, 1:1 reading lessons by qualified teachers. Last fall 45 children participated in online literacy tutoring from October 4 to December 13.

100% of students saw improved reading skills including:

Decoding abilities: Average improvement of 1.27 levels.

Reading comprehension: Average improvement of 1.2 levels.

Fluency: .52 levels. Fluency is measured based on the books they are reading during the assessment. On average students were reading books 2.7 F & P levels higher at the time of assessment.

Concepts of print: 89% of students mastered skill

Sight Words: Students did not make amterial gains for sight words.




