- Finance Committee
 - As of 2/28/23, Kipp projects \$2.79M in cash reserves, \$956K ahead of budget.
 - Days of cash for YE are projected at 71 days.
 - Improved revenue comes from two primary sources; Prop C and funding equity.
 - While expenses continue to trend ahead of budget, YE expense forecasts for Occupancy Service, Student Direct Expense, Office & Business Expense, and Transportation were all adjusted downward, improving the YE outlook.
 - In January, DESE had done a prior year adjustment to Kipp's revenue, which resulted in an increase of \$269,244. In February, that transaction was modified to a (\$116,910) adjustment, a \$386K swing in revenue between 01/23 and 02/23.
 - When contacted, DESE indicated that they had made a clerical error, inputting the wrong school's adjustment (in 01/23) originally. They then corrected that error in 02/23.

 - Additional Strategies Tried since last board meeting
 - Called all current transportation companies and asked if they can pick up 1 route
 - Priced out buying our own buses or a few buses and bringing it in house
 - Recommendation
 - Move to 4 First Student buses that pair with each other for HS and ES/MS
 - Change our policy to the following: "KIPP students can enroll in free bus transportation if they live greater than 3 miles from the campus they attend"
 - Benefits We stop over promising and under delivering to families and kids
 - We can focus our efforts on increasing Assist Drivers
 - It is easier to staff 4 drivers compared to 7, which hopefully decreases delays and missed routes
 - We can always increase the number of buses if it's going well
 - Drawbacks
 - We might lose more enrolled students
 - Longer route times (assuming 55 students per bus)
 - Other information
 - Number of students and distance from their campus
 - 369 students live less than 3 miles from their campus
 - 134 students live between 3 and 5 miles from their campus
 - 1 student lives 10 or more miles from their campus
 - This year we changed the policy to no longer bus within 1 mile of the campus
- Current Enrollment
 - We are on track to hit our numbers
 - Gap # doesn't change unless the student completes all enrollment documents.
 - The Budget Enrollment Target is our over-enrolled numbers for a total of 990.
 - We still have a waitlist in all grades expect 1st and 10th.
